Manufacturer's Declaration on Packaging Compliance

Packaging and Packaging Waste Regulation – Regulation (EU) 2025/40 (PPWR)

Issuer: Ocono APD Schlauchtechnik GmbH, Technologiering 12, 41751 Viersen

Scope of this declaration: Sales, grouped and transport packaging, including packaging components, used or supplied by Ocono APD Schlauchtechnik GmbH in connection with its products. This declaration does not cover the hose products or plastics themselves.

Declaration: Based on the supplier declarations, material information and internal packaging specifications available on the date of issue, Ocono APD Schlauchtechnik GmbH confirms that the packaging within the above scope meets the requirements of Regulation (EU) 2025/40 that are applicable from 12 August 2026 and on the respective statutory phase-in dates, insofar as they apply to the packaging concerned.

Material and packaging requirements

- **Heavy metals** – The sum of lead, cadmium, mercury and hexavalent chromium in packaging or packaging components does not exceed 100 mg/kg, in accordance with Article 5(4).
- **PFAS in food**–contact packaging – Where packaging is intended to come into direct contact with food, the limits in Article 5(5), applicable from 12 August 2026, are observed: 25 ppb for any individually targeted PFAS, 250 ppb for the sum of targeted PFAS and 50 ppm for PFAS including polymeric PFAS.
- **Packaging minimisation** – Packaging weight and volume are limited to the minimum necessary while maintaining functionality, protection and safety. Future empty-space requirements, including the 50% maximum ratio under Article 24 where applicable, will be implemented from the statutory application date.
- **Phased PPWR requirements** – Further requirements concerning recyclability, recycled content, labelling, reuse and related obligations are assessed and implemented according to their respective application dates and only where applicable to the packaging concerned.

Basis of confirmation and quality assurance: This declaration is based primarily on written confirmations and technical information from packaging and material suppliers, supplemented by internal reviews. Independent chemical testing is not performed unless separately required or agreed. Relevant supporting evidence is retained internally.

Ocono APD Schlauchtechnik GmbH reviews relevant supplier information and will inform affected customers without undue delay if a change becomes known that may materially affect the statements made in this declaration.

Legal status: This document is a general manufacturer's declaration for customer information. It is not the packaging-specific EU Declaration of Conformity pursuant to Article 39 and Annex VIII of Regulation (EU) 2025/40 and does not replace the technical documentation required under Annex VII. This declaration remains valid until replaced or withdrawn.
